Prayer Letter August-September

Dear W.W.N.T.B.M,'S Laborers,

Months are passing by very quickly. This means that our Lord Jesus will come soon. Every day we are getting closer and closer to His coming. The Lord says in The Word that nobody knows the day and hour, but He gave us some clues about the times of His coming, and we understand by them that the time is come.

Our church is going little by little. This Summer time has been very poor in one sense. Many went out for vacation, and you may know that here the vacation time is a whole month. Yes! You read it well. That means that for the entire month of August we had in our services some 5-7 people. Every year, when August is coming we tremble.

New family. We ask your prayers on this new Christian family from Peru. Their names are Fernando, Jovana, and Helen. They visited us some time ago, but now they are more permanently attending our church. They are faithful. This is a young family. Their little daughter is 5 years old, and they are expecting a child by February. Please, pray for their spiritual growth.

<u>Daniel and Gisela.</u> This past August they had been visiting their relatives in Argentina. Since they came back they have stopped coming to church. Only Gisela came once on Sunday morning. This week my wife and I have visited them. Daniel said that he needed to talk with me. So, I went yesterday to his office and talked. It seems that they feel bad for not being the type of Christians they should, and "they do not want to be hypocrites". I encouraged him by telling that the church is not for perfect people, rather it is for those that know they have needs. But the church is formed out of a group of people that are willing to follow Christ, and He has appointed pastor-teachers to make them grow in the grace and in the knowledge of Jesus Christ, our Savior. Finally, he told me: Well we will see you next Sunday! Praise the Lord! Please, pray for them, they have started a new business on their own, and this can be dangerous for them.

<u>Santiago and Gislaine.</u> This is a couple that has also started visiting us. They are from Brazil. They are a very young couple. He is about 23, and his wife about 20. They have a little girl named Eduarda (4 months). They are not saved, and do not come very faithfully, but when they come they hear well. **Pray for their salvation.**

<u>Pray for Miguel.</u> This is one of our members. He has recently done all the paperwork that is needed to be able to bring his family (wife and daughter) here with him. They are from Peru. It will take several months to get the answer from the official establishments. Let us pray for their coming.

<u>Chema and Gema.</u> We are continually praying for them and talking with them by phone. Recently he has hurt his feet and cannot walk or work. Since then his attitude seems that have changed. Please, continue praying for them. They are expecting their baby the second part of this month. We want to see them at church very soon!

More prayers. Please, pray for Jesus. He is attending our church from time to time. We have talked several times with him, but, though he understands some concepts, he is not willing to surrender to God.

We feel as if we are giving you too much homework to do asking you so much prayer, but you can also see some thanks given among our requests. People are coming back to church, some new people are visiting, and some are Christians willing to grow spiritually. Are not these things worthy of giving praises to God?

We greatly appreciate your prayers and faithful support. Many times when we give thanks for our food we give thanks to our Lord for all of you that out of your own effort are sending your moneys for us to work, and fill all our needs. God is supplying through you! May God bless you!
