We requested Villanueva de la Torre's City Hall (our town) to have a place in an outdoor market that they are going to start for the first time. We believe this can be a very good opportunity to pass out tracts and other Christian literature. One of the things we would like to do, besides talking to the people, is to lend them books that they will read and return. May the Lord provide to spread out His Gospel. Villanueva is one of the nine cities in which we are working and praying for. We believe this market will attract some of the people in the surrounding cities of these nine. Here in the pictures you can see some examples of the people attending these markets. The market in Villanueva is to be opened in October. Because of it being on Saturdays, we expect large crowds of both men and women. There are a lot of people asking some room for a booth for commercial purposes. They have to pay a lot of money. Our prayer is that they may allow us to have a little space for free. **Please, pray that the Lord may open this door.**



One of the saddest things we have recently experienced has been the Adair family returning to the States. They left Spain on June 13th to return to South Carolina where they used to live. He has gone back to his previous secular job. When Brother Bill told me of their departure, it was hard to believe. We love them so much, and agreed on so many things that he very soon become my buddy. Concerning our church, the people have suffered some with their departure of that dear family. But we must keep on. **This creates a new prayer request. We are still in need of some other missionary family to come and help us.**



We planned to leave the church with the Adair family while we went on furlough, but now we do not have anybody to leave the church with. **Please, pray that the Lord may provide some way that we may go and visit you after so long.** Some of our supporting pastors have requested it, and we also see the need.



Pray for my wife as she is voluntarily working in the Youth Camp's kitchen with other ladies. She is currently there. May this effort be for the sake of some souls for the Lord. She is the one serving in the middle of the picture.

During the months of July and August we are going to have several absences. Among many others sisters Isabel and Asunción, and Sister Mariana (a Romanian lady). She is Rumania because of her mother's surgery. Employees in Spain have a four week vacation that they take either in July or August.

Lastly, we want to acknowledge that we can work for the Lord here because you are there holding the ropes, of both prayer and financial support. We thank God for you constantly in our prayers.
