There is a veteran American missionary who wrote this to his churches. After I have asked permission for this quote, I share it with you: *"We have been missionaries for 37 years and we have never experienced such a devaluation in the dollar as we have in the last several years. I have attached a chart which illustrates the crux of the matter. Since the year 2001 the dollar has lost nearly 50% of its value in Europe.
