The Lord is so good to us! He is raising a man in our church who is starting to speak from the pulpit. He has never done that before. We have the custom of reading a Psalm at the beginning of the Sunday morning service, and then sharing some thoughts from it. Last February, I decided to give this opportunity to him and he is doing a good job. Maybe he is going to be a future preacher for our church. **Please, pray for Miguel.**
