Dear Praying Friends,

We sincerely apologize for being late in writing this prayer letter. As you may already know, we took a little furlough during the months of June and July. We flew from Spain to Chicago the 24th of May, and went to our daughter's house for two days. Our display and other things are at her house. Then, we had to travel all the way down to Ocala, FL., to attend a Missions Conference at Memorial Baptist Church. That was just the beginning. We were able to visit 17 churches, in addition to a week at Memorial (from Sunday to Sunday). We were able to spend another week at our Mission Family Week in New Bern, NC. (Monday - Friday). After much traveling, mainly in NC, SC, and VA, we finished our short furlough on the 29th of July. We stayed another week at our daughter's house to meet our newest grand-daughter, Isabel Grace. We do not need to tell you about her, you can see her picture.



Since we arrived back in Spain, we have been deeply involved in our ministry here. We landed in Madrid on Friday evening, and by Sunday we were preaching, and Fina was teaching her children's Sunday School Class.

After several years without any water baptismal services, we were able to baptize a mother and her 35 year-old son last year. Do you remember that Javi took his baptismal classes, but finally he said he would like to wait? Well, he just recently came to me and said: "Pastor, I am ready to be baptized." It is just wonderful what God can do even in 2010! The truth of the matter is that I was ready to ask him, but I am very glad that he decided to come to me first. Besides Javi, we have two new born-again souls that might get baptized as well. These two teenage boys accepted the Lord Jesus into their hearts a few months ago, after a Sunday School Class my wife taught. One of them, the first that got saved, is Efrain (11 year old black boy). The other one is Petru, a 12-year-old (pictured below). Please pray for them.



Bro. Josue, the man that kept the pulpit while we were on furlough, has told me that he has been praying about being full time in the ministry. He feels that God is calling him into His Work. The fact of the matter is that through the five years this family has been with us, I could see their spiritual growth. He does not know how to make it possible. He is 45 years old, unemployed, with his wife, Lidia, and their 18 year-old daughter. Please, pray for them also.



We are in need of a new desk computer. The one we have is giving us some trouble. I believe it is getting old (10 years). Some churches have asked us if we had any needs. At that moment we did not remember of any, but now we have one. Please pray that the Lord will provide one, maybe through some of you.

We are praying for you, acknowledging that our God is providing for us by using you. Thanks so much for praying and for supporting our ministry here in Spain.
