

Greetings to all of you from this dear country of Spain in the Beloved Name of Jesus. It seems almost impossible to believe that time has flown by so quickly. It seems it was just "yesterday" when we started this new year, and now we are already at the end of February!


The month of December was so busy for us. We spent most of our time preparing for the activities we had planned. To start with, my wife organized our Ladies' Special Meeting for Christmas. Almost forty women and young ladies attended; there were several visitors among them. It was a blessing to all. Then, we had our Christmas Supper for the whole church. On the 19th we held our Christmas Program for the children and the youth group. The children did very well with their singing and recitations. After that, two of our preachers presented a dialogue about the story of the well-known hymn, "Silent Night". Then, the young people presented a play in four acts called: "The Brilliant Daybreak", based on the prophecy of the coming of Jesus. Our little auditorium was filled with about sixty people; fourteen of which were first-time visitors. They heard the Gospel very plainly when I preached at the end. When everything was over, we gave gifts to all the children in the auditorium. It truly is more blessed to give than to receive!



Currently, we are preparing a Baptismal Service for March 13th. Once a week, we have some studies with the candidates to prepare them for baptism. It is our opinion that they should know about the fundamentals of the Faith in order to become members of our local church. There are six people attending these classes: (Pictured from top to bottom) Rafael, Clemente, Javi, Daniela, Mariana, and Alexandru (not pictured). Hopefully, all of them will be baptized. Please pray for them.

We are still praying for the unemployed that are among us. We invite you, who are in the States, to join us in prayer. Every Saturday, we get together from 7:00 to 9:30 A.M. to meet with our Lord, and to ask Him for help for the unemployed, as well as for

other personal needs. Before we pray, we take some time to study about serving God. I titled this study: *The Service of the Servant*. It is my hope that some of our men will be more encouraged to serve the Lord in our local church.
