Some years ago, they moved from Alcalá to Sevilla, in the South part of Spain. Since then, they have felt that it was wrong for them to move from our city, but have had to wait several years before they were able to come back. We have regularly kept in touch by phone. Last month, they finally moved back into our area. They said they are not going to move again, and that, "Once you get a good church, stay there."
