The words we read above are a truth that we have experienced through our lives in many occasions during our years of ministry. God’s work has to be performed together with God. May God help us not to work in our own strength and abilities and outside of His Company. We do not want to labor in vain!

For the first time, we could compound a choir. We prepared a cantata for Christmas. For our special program we had 12 visitors. Among them was our family doctor as well. His name is Mr. Urbina M.D. We are praying for him and talking with him from time to time. He enjoyed his visit with his woman (which is not his wife) and Jimena, a three-years-old girl that they have. He said that he felt very peaceful and admired our reverence in the service. They remained with us until we closed the church. **Please, pray for them.**



The children did a wonderful job in their Christmas presentation. My wife, Fina, worked hard with them, but finally we could see the results. It was a tremendous and joyful day! We preached on the topic—as the cantata theme was—“*Today You Could Celebrate Your First Christmas.*” Millions of people celebrate Christmas, but few celebrate it in a proper manner. If they would accept that the Babe, Jesus, was born in order to die for us, then they would be able to celebrate Christmas with the whole sense for the first time. **Pray for those visitors that heard the Gospel very plainly.**

My wife and I want to express our gratitude for all the Christmas cards you have sent for us. May the Lord have blessed you all at that precious season of the year. Really, it is a wonderful time to use the easy opportunities to spread the Gospel among our relatives, friends, and neighbors.

In January, we started a Bible Institute. We named it **Ebenezer Study Bible Center**, which in Spanish is, *Centro de Estudios Bíblicos Ebenezer* (C.E.B.E.). We have prepared a four-year curriculum that contains 216 hours in Bible (84 in N.T. and 84 in O.T.) and a total of 587 hours at the end of the four years. We have six students. Two of the men have been called to serve the Lord. **Please pray for the CEBE.**

This past January, we held our Missions Conference. Our new aim for missions is 7.656,00 €, which are some \$10,335.00. That is about \$861.00 per month. **Praise the Lord with us!**

Dear people, all this has been because of God’s grace, your prayers, and financial support. We do not want to forget these very important parts in our ministering here in Spain. May God bless you all!
