It seems like just yesterday when we came back from our short furlough, and we are already in November. *Tempus fugit.*

Preaching. The last six weeks, I have been preaching on the *Signs of His Second Coming*. We dealt with the political, economical, moral, and spiritual signs of our time. We must be ready and prepared to be with the Lord at any time, for the coming of the Lord is at hand. I believe these messages have had an impact in our people here. May God help us to not forget them too soon!

Bible Classes. Right now we are in the middle of our Bible Institute courses. We thank the Lord for our three students. They are very enthusiastically attending and studying the matters we teach them. Bro. Pedro Torres is also teaching. On Tuesdays, from 6:00-9:00 PM, I have three classes, and Bro. Torres teaches two classes on Saturdays from 9:00-11:00 AM.

In our last letter, we asked you to pray for **Andrea**. Just recently, I have found that she was saved a number of years ago. Later on, she attended a Charismatic-Pentecostal church and was baptized by a pastor-woman. Andrea was married to a black pastor, and then he asked her for divorce. She is now married to a Cuban unbeliever. You can see that her life has been a mess. After some time of attending our church faithfully, both Sunday services and Wednesdays, she got many things straight. I really believe she is saved. I need to talk with her about her baptism since it is not acceptable that she was baptized by a woman-preacher. She needs to be baptized properly!

Evangelization. Almost every Saturday morning, a little group from our church go by the *mercadillos* (some kind of free markets) and pass out tracts and Bible portions and talk to people. In the picture, I am speaking with a lady named **Gloria**. Pray for her.

Also every November 1st, people go to the cemeteries to bring flowers to their dead loved ones. This is a typical day for the people to clean out the tombs and the *nichos* as we call the windows in the buildings where the caskets are placed. Cemeteries are very different than yours in the USA. Lots of people do the same thing in the same day, so for us it is a great opportunity to handing tracts and bible portions. Even that day, being so special for the people remembering their people and being so close to death, it is amazing to see their hard hearts about the Lord Jesus.

23th Men's Prayer Conference. A week from today, on November 21-22, we are going to meet with many preachers and laymen around Spain for 24 hrs. to hear five preachers and to pray together. Some of them have to travel from five to seven hrs. to be with us. Pray for the preaching and the many prayers we are going to present before the Lord.
