Dear supporters,

First of all, we want to say that the Lord is good. If there is any discouragement in our lives or ministries, we must remember how good He has been with us in the past. Our God is still in Heaven, He gives and takes away, He is Lord of all, and He is in control of every little detail. We should remember that everything is for our good because He loves us so much. He gave us His only begotten Son. "He that spared not his own Son...how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?" Let us be encouraged! The Lord is on our side. Thank God for His goodness!

In our Bible Institute (C.E.B.E.) this year, we have another student. His name is David. A number of years ago, he was diagnosed with paranoia. He still is on medication today but is doing very well. He is attending another church, but he comes to ours almost every Sunday evening for our preaching. **We can see him growing. Please pray for him.** He is not attending a very good church in the mornings.

Since almost the beginning of the year, we have asked Villanueva's City Hall to allow us to use one of their rooms for Bible classes. Just last week, we received a positive answer. In fact, yesterday was our first meeting, and we had 9 people, three of which were unbelievers. We are so excited! We praise the Lord for opening such a door! **Please pray for this new ministry on Thursdays, 8:00-9:00 PM. May the Lord soon place a new church in this little town of about 7,000 people.**



Here are some facts about Villanueva. In the year 2000, when we arrived here, there were 1,300 inhabitants. In 2002, the population increased to 3,040. In the year 2008, 6,000 people lived here. Currently, there are about 7,000 + souls to save.

Pray also for our need. We need more souls saved. There are three more people attending our church fairly faithfully. Michael, a young, black man, and two more ladies, Ofelia and Felisa, are coming from different charismatic backgrounds.

We are working with those few members who try to say that just attending a Sunday morning service is sufficient. I realize that this is becoming a new style today in Christianity. However, we still believe that it is not the "morning" of the Lord; it is the "day" of the Lord! At least that is what my Bible says!

Pray for my wife as she is waiting for surgery. She has two problems: gall stones and a hernia. She is on the waiting list to have those surgeries. It may take several months before she is called. Meanwhile, she is experiencing pain. Some days she feels better than other days. Even so, she is a strong woman and goes forward with her duties. She has always been a faithful Christian and helpmate in our marriage and ministries. I thank God for her!

Samuel and I are doing well by the grace of God. Samuel is with us from Friday before lunch through Monday before lunch. He is our joy every week.

I want to take the opportunity again to say thank you so much for your faithfulness through praying and giving your support to this family. Often we give thanks to our Lord for using you to supply our needs and more. Thank you!
