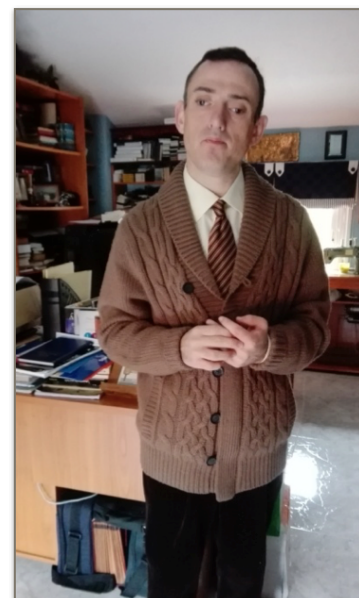

We have almost finished our short furlough. We arrived in the U.S. on March 22 at the Chicago airport. It was so kind of Bro. Williamson to bring the van we rent from B.M.T.M. (Baptist Missionary Transportation Ministry), located in Missouri, to the airport door. Then, we traveled up to Michigan to visit our children and our seven grandchildren. Five days later we started heading down to Harrisonburg, VA and then to Chesapeake, VA.

While there, Samuel began to have his problems. Samuel has never struggled in such a way as he did on this trip. The company that manufactured his medicine stopped making it, so Samuel's doctor prescribed a new medication. However, once the previous medicine was no longer in his system, Samuel started to become aggressive. He became very hesitant and out of control. On our way to Spartanburg, SC, it was late in the evening of Thursday, April 6th, when we stopped at our missions office in Kings Mountain. I asked Bro. O'Malley to find us some urgent tickets to bring Samuel back to Spain. Brother O'Malley provided us with tickets the next day. The cost of two round trips and a single one-way ticket cost over \$2,500. We flew out of Charlotte, NC that Saturday evening.

We left Madrid the next day at 3:00 PM. The following Wednesday, we arrived back in Charlotte at 7:30 PM. So, that is the whole story about our son, Samuel. We call him a couple of times every week, and he is doing well. It is hard to be separated from him for so long, but the time is drawing close for us to be together again.



We want to say thanks so very much to the family and several churches that helped us to pay that amount back to Bro. O'Malley. God evidenced His grace in our lives through your kindness. It is very difficult to express our gratitude.

On Tuesday, June 6th, we arrived back at our daughter's house to spend these few remaining days with them before we go back to Spain next Tuesday, the 13th. Please pray for our trip back home. Lord willing, next Sunday I will be back to my pulpit!

We praise the Lord for helping us sleep in some 21 different beds and travel more that 6,000 miles. The Lord is good!

Dear pastors, families and churches, we are very thankful for your words of encouragement and prayers during this special and challenging time we had to live. And besides all of that, thank you for your unwavering support throughout the years.

May the Lord use us and help us to find those in need of being saved by faith through God's grace. It is our responsibility to try to find them wherever they may be.
