We have had two young ladies express a desire to be baptized. They are sisters who have a large number of relatives. Many relatives and friends will come to see them, and now we have restrictions about our church gatherings. We are allowed to meet with only one-third of the church capacity. Now some of our people have to hear the preaching digitally.

A number of years, ago she had the first heart catheterization, and it turned into a bad thing for her. She was allergic to the contrast agent. This time, she was reluctant to do it because of what happened to her last time. The cardiologist encouraged her to do it because it was necessary to check out her heart. As she was getting out of the procedure, her heart collapsed, and they had to run back into the room to revive her. One main artery broke. They had to put seven stents in her to fix the situation. She had to stay in the ICU for two days, and then she spent seven days in the hospital cardiologist room. Fina is home now, but she feels very weak. She lost a lot of blood, and many other levels like potassium, iron, etc., are low as well. Please pray for her as she recovers very slowly. The situation was so difficult, and I had to pray that God would leave her with me for more years. Thank God I received the answer yes.

A while ago, two families from that area traveled to our church every Sunday. A few months ago, they stopped attending. It takes almost three hours to travel from there to our church, and we understand that it is really hard to do it consistently. We have been visiting them once or twice a month to be with them and encourage them to be faithful to the Lord by reading their Bibles, praying, and gathering together on Sundays. They have often said how good it would be if we could be there to start a new church there. There is no good church with sound preaching and teaching in that area. There are a few Charismatic churches, some gypsy churches, and one modern Southern Baptist church. Valladolid is a large town that has about 300,000 souls. We believe that the Lord has laid on our hearts to move there and start another church in that province that could be a witness of Christ for the glory of God.

We have already spoken with Pastor Renfrow and Bro. O'Malley (the president of our mission agency), and they both encouraged us to do it. Also, Bro. Torres, our coworker in our current church, agreed to take care of the church after we leave. This is a very important matter for us. Please pray that the Lord would guide us in these new steps we are now ready to take. We need your prayers and some financial help to get a storefront and prepare it to be a good place for us to meet and invite others to come. ***Please help us to glorify God in Valladolid!***

It is a huge thing for us to have you holding the robes as we are preparing to represent you in another part of Spain. Thank you so much for your faithfulness you have constantly shown to us for many years. You are a real blessing to us!
