Besides the preaching on Sundays, we are having Bible studies about the Tabernacle, seeing Christ in every aspect. We have also been studying how to

reach Catholics for Christ by going through every one of their doctrines. We had leadership training with the men, and during the summer vacations, I have been teaching and counseling our teenagers as they face this rotten world in which they have to live. Two young ladies are in charge of the special music at church. Both play the piano; one plays a traversed flute and the other plays violin.



During the last month, we started to record the messages and put them on Facebook and YouTube. If any of you want to see and listen to our preaching, you may do it. I have been told (since I don't know much about these devices) that you may have them translated into English. If you know how to do it, we would be honored if you watched. I always say that I was born too early to be able to comprehend all these electronic functions. Also, you can help us by sharing them with other people, especially Hispanics. In many of your churches, you have missionaries who know Spanish or serve the Lord in Hispanic countries.

Every two or three weeks, I try to do that, and we enjoy it very much. I try to leave home at 8:00 in the morning and arrive at about 10:30-11. Then the train ride takes about an hour to reach Madrid from the place where he lives. You should see how happy he is. In the evening, we take the ride back and leave him at his home about 6 pm, and I go back to Valladolid, arriving about 9:00.
