It seems like yesterday that we started a new year, and we are already in February! I have a couple of things that have been a blessing for us here in our church. Two souls have graciously been saved, a young man and an elderly lady. Both were regularly attending our services, and you could see that the Lord was working in their hearts about salvation. The lady's name is Tía Pati, she is an aunt of another lady at church, but now we call her Sister Pati. One day, after the service, she wanted to talk with me. She needed to tell me that she wanted to receive the Lord Jesus as her Savior. She prayed by herself to ask the Lord to forgive her sins and come into her heart. You could see the joy on her face after her prayer!

The young man's name is David. He was attending both our services and Bible studies. It seemed that he already had accepted the Lord Jesus because of his response to my questions. Then, one day being along with him, I asked if he ever asked the Lord Jesus to come into his heart. His answer was, "O yes, several weeks ago I did it in my room. I asked Him to save me. We have started to pray for a missionary family that would be willing to come and help us here in our church. Our desire is that they would take the church one day. We are praying that they know conservative music and play some instruments. We have two young ladies that play the piano, traverse flute, and violin. May the Lord provide the ones we need and be effective in our church. This is a significant request, please pray.

Once more, I want to express my gratitude for your abundant prayers and generous support you faithfully are sending both to Heaven and Spain. I often thank our Lord for all of you and your efforts on our behalf while we are here in Spain.
