In my last prayer letter, I referred to the need we have for a couple or a family to come and help us here in Valladolid. Please continue to pray for this need. It would be best if we work together before I leave this ministry. I do not want to leave it without a man of the Lord taking my place. **This is a very significant prayer request.**

We want to thank Emmanuel Baptist Church for the love offering they sent for us to buy the baptistry. Though we had not bought it yet, they graciously gave us the total amount we needed. Hopefully, we will be able to have the baptismal service in the coming weeks. Pray for that coming day. Three believers are going to be baptized, Lord willing.

A few weeks ago, after preaching in the evening service, I had to go to the emergency room due to an intense UTI. The ambulance came to take me to the hospital. I felt cold and trembling throughout my body. I spent three days in the hospital. However, something good came out of that. The man in the picture is named Hector. I had an excellent opportunity to present him with the plain of salvation. He said he would consider what I told him. His wife came to visit him while we were talking. She said that she was Orthodox, though she confessed that she only occasionally went to church. Then I told her that it does not matter which kind of religion she may practice, any religion was made by men, and none of them may give her the salvation she needs. Then I told her that what matters is who is Jesus to her. She kept silent, bent her head, and said: “This is a good question.” No decision was made, but they heard the gospel that day for the first time. **Please also pray for their salvation: Hector and his Romanian wife.**



Here in Spain, we suffer the consequences of the Ukrainian war regarding electricity and gasoline. Just an example: We pay \$2.10 per liter. So, it takes around 50 liters to fill a tank; it costs \$105 each time. As a result, electricity and domestic gas increased more than 300 times since last year.

The Lord is coming, dear brethren. Maranatha! More and more leaves are seen on the fig tree. The summer is closer. The Lord will soon come to take us up with Him forever. ***“Wherefore comfort one another with these words.” - 1 Thessalonians 4:18***

Thanks so much, dear people, for your faithfulness in praying and giving to that cause of Christ. You demonstrate that you are willing to sacrifice for your missionaries, both with your time and financial sacrifice. May our Lord bless you for all.
