We would like to ask you to pray for the four people who will get baptized in the first part of September. There are two ladies, Adriana, and Pati (short from Patricia), and two men, David and Santi (short from Santiago, which is James). Three of them were saved in our ministry. The fourth, Adriana, was baptized a number of years ago in another kind of "church" by a lady pastor (Shepherdess). Since she came to our church, she has grown so much! She is now sure of her salvation by grace and is ready to be baptized in a biblical manner. She knows that her previous baptism was not from God; rather, it was totally unscriptural. Please pray for them and the service, that it may be for God's glory and a good testimony to the people attending.

Another blessing we have to share with all of you, dear people, is it seems the Lord is providing a prospective pastor for the future of our church. A local church in our area brought a young family from Venezuela to assist the church. The Lopez family came fully supported by the church, but unfortunate circumstances at the church left this family searching for God's next direction. Bro. Jorge now has no job and no money to return home. Our church and I began ministering to the family, and they now attend our church. The little girls' behavior speaks well of their parents! They are very well-educated, tender, obedient, and nice children. I am getting to know Bro. Jorge through meeting with him each

week. In our first conversation, we talked for four hours. He explained their situation, told me about his academic preparation, biblical doctrine, and convictions. Afterward, I told him that we are praying for a future pastor for our church. He answered, "Pastor, I was praying to know what I should do...I believe this could be the door the Lord is opening for my family and me. You have been the answer to our prayers." I am excited about this prospect and believe he could be a good pastor for our church. Please pray for the Lopez family and our church as we seek God's direction.
