He is very energetic and enthusiastic in his preaching and has good Biblical standards and solid preaching. I hope one day we can have a church that may support him and his family full-time. He and his dear wife, Dayana, have two daughters, Alisbet (7) and Jocabet (5). His needs are to find a permanent job, renew his driver's license, and find a used car for their personal use. A special thankful note. We have received an unexpected love offering as a gift for us in the amount of \$715.50 from Bethel Baptist Church in Hampton, VA. They sent it out of their Missionary Conference. We thank the Lord and these people for having such a love for their missionaries. At the end of the day, when I have to come back, he stays at his place telling everybody what a big day he has enjoyed!

Just a personal note. Since my dear wife went to be with her Lord, I feel very lonely. I never expected that I would survive her. When it happened, I felt that the whole world was upon me. I can say to honor the truth that my God is helping me at this hour, but I miss her a lot. Her company meant much more to me than I ever could expect. She has been such a good lady, spouse, and companion to me for almost fifty years of marriage. Thanks so much to those I know that still pray for me.
