He is not baptized yet, but he did not feel right about working at such a place. His conscience was not satisfied, and the Lord provided another job at Carrefour, a big food company here in Spain. Now his schedule is much better, having a wife and a 2-year-old daughter. We thank the Lord, for He is good!

**A new couple at our church:** We have a couple that, for a month, has attended our services and Bible Classes faithfully. They are very fine believers. They came from another sister church about an hour away from Valladolid, but now they have decided to move to our church. They are not yet members of our church, but they already asked about membership. They say they are learning things they never learned before. Their names are Hector and Isabel. Pray for them.

There is another new family that comes driving from Benavente, an hour and a half away from our church. They spend the whole day with us. They are the Ricardol family: Edwin, Roberta, and Moisés, (Moses in English). They eat lunch with us at church and then come to rest at my house so that they can stay for the evening service as well. They are also very faithful Christians. Their ministry is to help children. They are trying to start an orphanage where they live.

**Moving to another apartment in November:** Lord willing, I am planning to move to another apartment. Pray for the work I will face in moving everything: furniture, appliances, clothing, books, devices, and files I have kept, and then in putting everything as it was here! Pray for me, dear brethren.

Concerning my son Samuel, he is so very happy where he stays. About every three weeks, I go and spend the day with him. For those that know him, you know how he likes trains. We ride for over an hour on them one way and the same to come back. While in Madrid, we eat pizza, which he likes a lot, and then we have ice cream, which he loves so much, well, both of us. I love him so much, and the same he to me. He lives some two hours and a half from Valladolid, where I live. So, I have to drive five hours round trip. But I enjoy so much the time we can get together! He is in very good health and always is happy. The Lord is good to him.

I cannot finish this letter without expressing how much I appreciate your generosity in giving for us to be able to be in the ministry trying to raise this church named Iglesia Bautista Vida Nueva Valladolid (New Life Baptist Church in Valladolid). Our people often say in their prayers, "Thank You for the churches that support our pastor." And I join that sincere prayer. The Lord is good!
