**The need for 15 passenger vans have not been more evident than this week. Why? It is camp week that is why! Not only are there several kids from the orphanage going, but several kids from the village are going as well. Another two churches, who have no transportation, called me thinking I could take them, and we will try to accommodate them but it looks impossible to help them find rides. We just counted those who will ride in my 15 passenger van and find that we have given permission to 34 to ride with us. I have a small 4 ft. trailer in which we hope to put the luggage and junk. We were hoping to use the under seat space for luggage but they have decided to put some of the skinnier kids under the seats. I am thankful that I will be in indiana presiding over a wedding during camp week.!!! Delia will remain here and be involved with the whole mess. I know that they will be insisting on having a convoy all the way to the camp. I think the Lord has answered my prayers by not having me involved in any more Mexican convoys. I think that there are only 4 vans available for the 10 or 11 churches involved in the camp. I have already seen a couple of the cars they will be using and I get cold chills just thinking about the ride out there. One of the vans has blue smoke rolling out of it so bad that it looks as if is driving in a dense fog. Once they get there, I am sure that they will have a great time. They always do.**

**We are playing host to more than 40 people, who have come down from a church located about 50 miles south of Eagle Pass, TX. Both the pastor and his wife are graduates from our Bible college. Joel Ramirez, took a tiny church in the state of Coahuila, and has done a good job. They now have 46 adults as members and a whole bunch of lil'uns. The town is located 18 hours north of Guadalajara, and they rented a bus for four days. Several unsaved people came with them and so far, 5 have made professions of faith. They will be starting an extension of our Bible college this year and should begin with about 10 students. Liliana Sarmento, and Delia, are making up books from the school to take back with them.**

**Crescencio Galaviz, and Liliana, are in Guadalajara this summer working on materials for the coming year for the Yucatan school. We are also making books for the college and my office has gotten much smaller than unusual. All I can tell you is, it was a good thing that I went on a diet as they are not leaving me much room in which I can negotiate.**

**We will be hosting a few guests from the States this month with Sharlene Clark, and her daughter Leslie. Then, we will have Archie McGahan, and his dear wife Flora and with them will be Freddie Daniel 3<sup>rd</sup>. It is going to be a fun time.**
