Greetings from Beanland:

Our field conference will be held in Cancun the third Monday of January 2010. This conference will be different from others in years past. We will not be having a banquet for the graduates. Instead, we will be going into three different churches and preaching evangelistic messages. We are praying that many souls will be saved. Everyone is welcome to join us.

Here in Guadalajara, we have already begun classes in the Bible College, and have eight new students. Six of the students are men and we are praying that none will get discouraged or drop out. I believe that all of them are high school graduates. One young man is a university graduate with a degree in engineering. He wants to become a pastor. We should have six graduates here this year and they are all men. In the past there were more women than men interested in the things of God. Recently, however, we have seen an increase in interest among men who want to become pastor's assistants or preachers. Needless to say, we are thrilled to have these young men in the College.

A note of interest for us is that one of the students is from the extreme northwestern part of Mexico, and another is from the extreme southeastern part of the country. Culture shock will soon be setting in as most of them have never been away from home and will not even be able to go home during the Christmas vacation.

The church that I am pastoring will be receiving seven new members this next week. This is a result of illegal Mexicans coming back from the U.S.A. Most Mexicans who receive Christ while living in the States never join churches when they return to Mexico because they are afraid of their families. In this particular case, almost all of the family members are Christians. I pray they will be a blessing to our church.

This week we had the pleasure of hosting Freddy and Brittany Daniel. They were here checking the prices for housing, food, insurance, etc. They will soon be on deputation with the hopes of coming down to be missionaries and help with the burden of this work. They are close to the age of Jerry Jr. and Itzen, and their talents will compliment the talents of Jerry and Itzen. It is our prayer that they will be able to raise their zillion dollars as soon as possible. With them working alongside Jerry Jr., this ministry ought to have a good future.
