With Fall approaching, we will once again be meeting with pastors at regularly scheduled fellowship meetings. We also are beginning to plan visits to various churches in the Denver area on Wednesday nights and possibly some Sunday nights to better get acquainted, and introduce more pastors to WWNTBM, as well as our ministry of helping church planting in the West. Sue will be giving a workshop at an area-wide ladies retreat September 11, and we pray the Lord will use this to introduce us to more pastors' wives, too. The Lord has also opened up opportunity to have another piano seminar for the Denver area churches in October. Arvada Baptist Church will be sponsoring it, and we are sending out notices to many churches where we might be of help to their pianists and musicians. We want the Lord to use this additional ministry as He sees fit.

We are SO thankful for this open door and ask you to pray for Julie. We are praying that now that she has heard the Gospel, we will be able to have many more contacts with her, and she will come to Christ.

Thank you for praying for the Teen Mission Team from Candor, NC, that came in July to help Northrange Baptist Church. There were 9 teens, plus sponsors (and family) who served the Lord in varied ways while here. We were able to develop and print a new church brochure and flyers for backyard Bible clubs. The teens distributed hundreds of brochures, flyers and Gospel tracts during their week with us to many surrounding developments. They also held backyard Bible clubs in two neighborhoods. It was truly a blessing to see how the Lord used this time in the lives of many of the teens to further their spiritual growth. It was also a blessing to see unsaved children hear the Gospel! Praise the Lord for the work that was done that week.
