After much prayer, and discussion with our people, we decided to serve in helping however needed at Living Waters Baptist Church for the next year, but maintain our weekly Bible Studies in Rimrock, continue to support the missionaries we were committed to, and reevaluate the situation in one year. We then discussed this with Pastor Messick and Paul Sondergaard (assisting the pastor), and they were thrilled with our decision. They talked with their church folk and all were in agreement. Since we made that decision, we have been busier than ever. Sue spoke at a ladies' Bible Study, and Mike has been teaching Sunday School, preaching often in the morning or evening services. Also we and our Rimrock people have been very active in all the music. Recently, Pastor Messick has been very ill with COVID-19, so Mike has been preaching much more, and we both are working with the people to have a Christmas program, etc. We are not sure how long the Lord will have us serving at Living Waters Baptist Church, but at least for now we truly believe the Lord is using us in the way He wants and the folks at Living agree. And we are just so thankful that He is using us to serve Him!

Mike's part-time Amazon business has ceased since September, so our income has diminished significantly. But God has provided every need through extra unexpected gifts, etc. Sue continues to give piano lessons, mostly to those who want to learn hymnplaying to serve the Lord. She just had her Christmas recital (after not having any

> recitals since the pandemic began), and it was exciting to see the progress of these students! We are so thankful for His continued provision and guidance in our lives and ministry! He never fails and we
