She has been coming to church faithfully, and even went to a ladies retreat at West Branch this past weekend. We are thankful for this opportunity to work with her and her two boys. Sue was able to teach Sunday School a few weeks ago, and became more acquainted with the children. But her ministry in music keeps her busy in the church, playing for each service as well as organizing special music.

Mike continues to preach and teach, both at Living Waters and other churches in the area. Currently, he is teaching a series from the book of Colossians in Sunday School. But he also takes an active part in preparing visual aids for each service with PowerPoint.
