- + Please pray for upcoming Christmas activities at the church. We are currently working on a Christmas program, involving both the children as well as the adults in music.

Please pray that some of the churches we visited might take us on for monthly support. Also, that the Lord might lead us in visiting new churches here in the West in the coming months.
