God gave us a special blessing this past month that we never would have dreamed! A couple was referred to us by one of Sue's piano students who had a baby grand piano they were wanting to donate to our church. It is a Kawai baby grand, and is absolutely beautiful! Since our church is small, our platform did not extend the full width of the building. But God even had that all worked out. Each year a retired couple from Iowa has visited the church for the purpose of helping with building needs, repairs, etc. This year, the Beebouts came just before we were having the piano moved to our building. With the assistance of a couple of our men, they were able to extend the platform and even had enough of the same carpet to make it uniform! Just a few days later, we had the piano moved to our auditorium. What a delightful addition it has been to our services!

In addition to the remodeling of the platform, they also helped to install electricity in a small building behind or church building so we may use it for additional Sunday School space.
