It's hard to believe that we have already been here almost a year and what a year it has been! Things are slowly getting back to normal here after the major scare of the Covid-19 has died out. Masks are still required in most places and mandatory washing of hands with alcohol when entering stores. Everyone from the church has been able to return to their jobs and none of them lost their job as a result of the quarantine, though many places did go out of business because of the shut down. Because of the restrictions to the number of people allowed in buildings, specifically churches being 30% of capacity, we have been meeting at the Dickens' house because they have a large, covered porch area that allows for open air meetings. We have seen a good return of members and even a new family that visited a couple weeks before the quarantine. The wife and son of this family were saved during the quarantine through the Zoom and Facebook services! The husband made a profession of faith a while back while attending a different church.
