Our computer went down in late November and we took it to the repair shop but after two months of waiting on parts they were unable to fix it. Fortunately it was still under warranty and we were able to get a brand new computer late February. I have been playing catch up since then, because I was unable to do much without it.

We have continued services at the Dickens' house and have wonderful services with many people coming faithfully, as well as a good number of visitors! One of those visitors, a lady with three boys, came as result of the family I mentioned in our last letter. She was nervous about coming because her husband did not want her to come to church, but she came anyways. After staying in contact with her Noel began a Bible study with her and her sister and they both received Christ as their Savior this past Monday! Praise the Lord for new names written in glory!! The young man that Joel and Bro. Dickens have been studying with has recently become the assistant, and we are praying that, if it is the Lord's will, one day will be the pastor here.

Joel continues to do his Portuguese lessons three days a week and is progressing well. He is doing two different Bible studies each week and is also sharing the teaching responsibilities of the teen Sunday school class with three other men in the church and as well as doing a short meditation at the beginning of Sunday school each week before separating in classes. Please pray for a men's gathering that our church and another church from nearby will be having on Easter weekend. We hope to have many visitors and to establish contacts to reach with the Gospel. Joel will be doing activities about survival, applying Biblical principles. He will also be preaching Sunday night, May 30th.
