We are still not sure exactly when we will be able to resume services. We hope to be holding services in our building by the end of May. As things stand right now, our plan is to continue services in our building ASAP. We still have a lot of outreach material that needs to be distributed. We are tentatively planning for a "Grand-Opening" type service in late August. We are hopeful that things with this pandemic have settled down enough by then that we could resume our mass literature distribution by mid-July and into August leading up to that service. Please pray with us that we would be able to do this. We would also welcome any groups that would like to come and assist in this effort in July/August.

In a time when it seems that everything has come to a screeching halt, it is exciting to watch the Lord continue to build His church. We are excited to look back at this time and see where and how He has worked and done exceeding abundantly above all we could as or think.

Would you please pray for our city. Lawrence has become a "hot spot" for this virus. At last check we had over 1,800 confirmed cases and 80 deaths in our city alone. Please pray that the Lord would stop the spread of this deadly virus and that He would work in the lives of the people that have been so effected in our city. We are excited to see the Lord bring about a great harvest in our city.

Please pray for wisdom for us as we minister during this time. We are praying for you that the adverse effects of this pandemic would be minimized in your lives and that God would be glorified through all of this.
