We were also able to interact with our neighbors, many of whom showed an interest in visiting the church. Several Bibles were distributed, and at the end of the event, I was able to share a quick gospel message.

We were glad to have some people come and help from our newest supporting church Grace Bible Church in Dracut, MA. They were a great blessing, and we are thankful for their partnership in ministry.

Please continue to pray as we seek to strengthen our financial support. In our last letter, I shared that we had lost approximately \$1,000 per month in support over the previous year. We are currently at about 75% of our needed support level.

We praise the Lord that one new church has recently taken us on for support and that several others have shared plans to increase their monthly support. Altogether, we have added \$275 per month. Several churches and individuals have also sent special gifts to help bridge the gap. Some have even given anonymously. Though we may not know your names, we sincerely want to say, "Thank you."

Over the next few months, I have several local meetings scheduled to present the ministry and seek additional support. We are praying that the Lord will open doors for more meetings.
