Dear Gospel partners,

In our own weak hearts, at times there's great uncertainty when it comes to missions. *Church members* wonder if they can afford to give an offering on their limited budget. *Pastors* wonder how the Faith Promise might somehow increase. *Missionaries on deputation* wonder when they will get to the field and *missionaries on the field* wonder if hearts will ever respond to the Gospel.

Yet, this week, God reminded me that missions is not a "hope-so" endeavor, but its success is guaranteed because it is anchored in the conquering glory of our God. He showed me this from the first declaration on missions that we find in all of Scripture.

It's in Genesis 3:15. The first sin has been committed. God's creatures stand condemned. Yet in grace, God seeks after man and announces to Satan his sentence, "And **I will** put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; **it shall** bruise thy head, and **thou shalt** bruise his heel." Since our last update, God has been very good to allow us to present our ministry in many churches. Since August, we have had the privilege to present our burden in churches in Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Florida, Oklahoma, Texas, Louisiana, Indiana, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. At present time, promised support is at 40% of our need to leave for the mission field, and actual support is somewhat less than that. In all, we maintain our target date for the field at the first week of January 2020.
