Membership transfer

As supporting churches, and churches where we have visited, I want to inform you of a change that we have made in our church membership. Previously, we were members of Calvary Baptist Church in Statesville, NC, where Pastor Chris Haizlip was our pastor. However, for some time, I had been considering transferring our membership to "Iglesia Bautista Tabernaculo" in Greenville, SC, where Pastor Juan Carlos Fernandez serves as pastor. Pastor Fernandez' relationship with me has been one of mentorship since I met him a few years ago. In fact, when I served as pastor, we took our key church leaders to have a time of training with Pastor Fernandez in Greenville.

Since I have been on deputation, "Tabernaculo" was one of the first churches to begin supporting us and Pastor Fernandez and I have stayed in contact. Having been on deputation, I began to see the benefit of having a Spanish-speaking church as a sending church and having a Hispanic pastor as a mentor to give wisdom in reaching Hispanics across Latin America. The church itself has several families from various Latin American countries as members, which will only help us facilitate taking our counseling ministry into those countries later on.

Pastor Haizlip and I had a great meeting concerning this matter in February, and we both agreed that it would be best if we were to transfer our membership to "Iglesia Bautista Tabernaculo." With the blessing of both pastors and both churches, we have made this transfer. There is no change as far as our support address, and our mission agency, but nevertheless, I wanted to inform you all of this adjustment going forward.
