along with our "Fundamentos Familiares" family counseling sessions that we will be restarting in October. Also, several of our folks have been visiting a nearby town called Saravia and started a van route there. It's been great to see good attendance at our preliminary services that we have held (photos below).







A brother has donated a piece of land to plant the church, and another family donated the white tent in the pictures above. These are the resources we will be starting with. 
Why do "Grupo Esperanza" and Hope House exist? (see next page)

Construction phases:

PHASE 1: Fence property, build first floor of dorms, chapel, kitchen, infirmary.

PHASE 2: Build staff offices, work areas, security checkpoint.

PHASE 3: Build second floor of dorms, gym.

Dorms (beds are Chapel/ bunk beds so allthere's space here for 30 men. purpose In the future we room for would build. preaching second floor to and dining house 60. We plan to use this space Staff offices for work areas to train the men in a trade.
