"MEXICAN INDEPENDENCE DAY" ACTIVITIES

Mexican culture is big on events and get-togethers, and many churches capitalize on that, especially on holidays. So, back on September 14-15 (Sat.-Sun.), we decided to do a special outreach for the Mexican Independence Day weekend. Our team of about 20 workers went out on Saturday, Sep. 14th, into two neighboring towns, Tlacaele and Coltsingo, and



invited everyone we could for an "Afternoon at the Movies". We showed a movie about William Booth, served popcorn and Kool-Aid, and preached the Gospel. In all, the Lord permitted us to share the Gospel with around 300 new people that Saturday (picture above).

The aim, though, was also to invite them to our special "Noche Mexicana", the next day for the evening service at our church. I am glad to report that that day was also a success, with many visitors hearing about salvation (photos below). In these staunchly Catholic towns, any time anyone attends a Gospel-giving church, it is a grand victory.







NEW WORKER AT HOPE HOUSE

Bro. Alberto Cordoba, an ex-addict rescued by Christ, is the brother of one of our men at Hope House. Earlier this year, he came to visit his brother, and God opened his heart to come and help. We needed a full-time worker within the ministry and Alberto has been that. He guides the men toward Scripture through devotions and preaching, as well as training them in practical areas of self-discipline, musical training, and personal evangelism training. He has been a great addition to the ministry.



PROGRESS ON HOPE HOUSE FOR LADIES



I wanted to send this letter updating you on how Hope House for Ladies had officially opened and was serving 10 ladies already... but that has not happened yet. We have begun renting the facility and purchasing needed things (Bibles, reading materials, tables, beds, mattresses, a refrigerator and stove, etc.). However, the lady that we had designated as our director decided not to come on full-time. We have learned to

wait to begin such a rigorous ministry until God has supplied the right person for leadership. So we have not opened full-time yet.

However, there is progress. Alessandra, who God gave victory over her addiction through our ministry, is serving at the Hope House for Ladies facility daily by giving Bible studies to ladies whose families battle addiction (photo on right). She is also preparing the house we have rented for its inauguration. Alessandra will continue serving in the ministry once it begins.



In December, a lady missionary is going to meet with us and interview for the director position. The situation looks favorable, but please pray for this matter, and that we might begin this vital ministry very soon.
