We were within five minutes of our destination when a man ran through a stop sign and hit our car. We thank the Lord that, though there was some significant damage to the car, no one was injured. The man that hit us was a Muslim fellow. I was able to take just a brief moment to explain to him that the reason we were not mad at him was because Jesus Christ had saved us from our sins and that he could be saved as well. I was also able to give him a tract. Please be praying that this man will come to know the Lord.



Once we arrived at the Toyota dealer, I explained to the mechanic the situation and that we were Christians. He sent us to the lobby only to come and get us some moments later. After assessing the significant body damage, broken tie rods and bent struts, he commented, "You must have said the right prayer today." I was able to tell him that we had multiple people that pray for us. They were not even able to pull the car into the garage before it broke down, but because of YOUR prayers for us, we were able to walk away safely and get it to the shop without much of a problem. Thank you for your constant intercession on our behalf.
