The New Year celebration here in Chuuk is LOUD. As soon as the clock strikes midnight on January 1, people begin to bang on pots, pans, water buckets - you name it. Then comes the endless honking of car horns and blaring radios. Through the day, groups of kids (usually) come walking down the street chanting about "Happy New Year, we want candy!" The same thing happens a bit more the night of January 1, and then it is all over - peace and quiet at last!

As we reflect back on 2018 we must recognize the goodness of God. We were able to see six souls make professions of faith this past year! We praise the Lord for it. Our church hosted its first VBS; Pastor Mike and I began a small visitation program (from which we saw three of those souls saved); and I was able to finish preaching through the book of Titus and begin a new series on Basic Christian Growth. Furthermore, Sarah started a growing Sunday School for the kids in our church as well as a ladies Bible study to encourage one another in the Word. Our language skills have progressed and now I (Josh) sound about like a 3 or 4 year
