Dear Faithful Friends,

As I'm sitting down to write to you this afternoon, it is a rainy, humid, sticky day and we know that as warm as it has been the last few days, we have hotter weather to come in the next few months. I know that many of you have been dealing with your fair share of precipitation of a much colder kind! Isn't it amazing to know that though there are so many time zones and weather patterns separating us, we are all still serving the same Creator in unique ways. Thank you for being faithful in your service wherever you are reading this letter. We pray that you remain faithful to the Lord as you serve Him.

This year already feels like it is speeding up and not backing off! In the English side of the church I have been preaching through a series on basic Christian growth. Sarah is also continuing her children's Sunday School class at the church and is, at this moment, in a meeting with a lady that runs a local women's organization discussing a library ministry that my wife will be working on. Two days per week Sarah will host a children's reading program at the Chuuk Women's Counsel. We are excited to see what God will do through this!



We want to give praise to the Lord that, in the beginning of 2019, Pastor and I were able to see another lady saved during our visitation. As we sat in their house, Pastor Mike asked about eternal life. Without hesitation this lady acknowledged that she had not received salvation of the Lord and asked if Pastor could show her how to be saved. Right there in front of her family she accepted Jesus as her Savior! We were also able to see a 17 year old young lady saved just this past Thursday. She sat and listened intently as Pastor explained the Gospel to her; right there she decided that baptism was not able to save her and that only faith in Jesus

can! Pray for Pastor and I as we seek to follow up with, as well as disciple, those that are coming to the Lord.

We know many of you have been praying for our ongoing legal situation. On January 18 I was interviewed before an appeals committee regarding their efforts to deport us. I opened my mouth and the Lord filled it, for which I am grateful! We were supposed to hear back within 15 days, but they could not tell us whether that was calendar or business days, so we waited for both. The latest we should have heard was February 8. However, it was not until March 11 that Immigrations came to the house and presented me with paperwork denying our appeal to stay. Legally, they are over one month late with their delivery of the determination, so we will bring it before the Supreme Court in a final appeal. Please continue to pray.



On Wednesday mornings I have been meeting with two local men about my age and having a Bible study with them. We are going through the book of John. One man, Joseph, is a faithful friend and brother. The other man that meets with us leaves us with some doubts about his salvation. Please pray that this other gentleman would have a clear understanding of the Gospel. However, we are thankful to the Lord for the opportunity to meet together and grow together in the Word - we are here to learn alongside of the Chuukese people and we love doing so! Sarah's Bible study continues, though it has seen a decrease in faithful attendance. Joseph's wife, Myurie, is faithful to attend and Sarah and

Myurie are able to have wonderful fellowship together. Please continue to pray that they would be serious about their spiritual growth.

One prayer letter can hardly sum up everything going on in our lives here, nor can it accurately express how grateful we are to you. We know that it is God that meets our needs, but we also know that He uses people to do so. Thank you for being used of God to keep us here on the field. We love being here and we love representing you! Continue to watch our facebook page, Chuukbound, as we have been trying to more consistently upload content and provide a look into our every day lives. Thank you for your faithfulness, love, and support.
