We already deeply miss our home in Chuuk, but it is so good to be reunited with those that we love and have missed here for so long.

We have now been back in VA for a month, and what a month it has been! We landed on Sunday, July 3, and by that Wednesday I came down with COVID, Thursday night Sarah came down with it, and by Friday morning Milena had caught it! Welcome back, right? The following week was simply getting back on our feet and figuring out life in America again. Then came our home church's VBS. I was part of the cast for the production as well as a teacher's assistant and a Gospel presenter. Needless to say, it was quite a busy week being back! Finally, this past week, we were able to get away for a little bit with Sarah's family and do a family vacation on a lake. We enjoyed that immensely.

God has graciously (and I would use the word "miraculously" in every sense of the word) provided us a house in the country for well below our budget. We are deeply grateful to our home



church, and especially my dad, Mike, who spent about a month renovating the house to make it livable. All glory to the Lord, but He also uses willing servants, so we are thankful to them as well!

Sarah is doing well with the baby. We were able to find out that we have a baby boy on the way and we are certainly excited! Right now she is in the extremely uncomfortable part of pregnancy, but we are grateful to the Lord that there were no indications of heart issues or a cleft lip.
