Dear Pastor,

From December 8 through December 18, we were in Myanmar. It seems to me that things are even more scrutinized in Myanmar than they are in China. All of these believers serve under difficult circumstances. Please pray earnestly for them. We spent most of our time with Timothy, Daniel and Abraham. These men are faithfully serving Christ in establishing local churches and training future leaders. The Lord willing we will return sometime this year for another visit.

If the schedule holds, 2008 will be another busy year. Darleen and I covet your prayers. We have done our best to prayerfully establish a schedule; however, our greatest concern is being where the Lord wants us to be when He wants us to be there. We know that so much depends on answered prayer. Our hearts are encouraged to know that so many servants of Christ are holding us up in prayer.

It has been our joy to serve with World Wide New Testament Baptist Mission since 1985. Many of you have stood by us all through these years. We cannot possibly thank you enough.
