In January I had the opportunity to visit India. My purpose was to interview four men that had made application to World Wide New Testament Baptist Mission. Three of these men are the sons-in-law of Brother Eric Franks, and one is the son of Brother Ramesh Kumar.



I also had the joy of preaching a Bible Conference and graduation for Dr. Kumar. Dr. Kumar established


the Shalom Biblical Baptist Church. Under the church ministry, he has started an orphanage, school and Bible college. I did not have the time to visit Dr. Eric Franks ministry on this short trip; however, I have in the past. Dr. Franks started a church in Bangalore and his son-in-law is now the pastor of that church. Brother Franks has much the same ministry as Brother Kumar. Each have started a number of churches, as well as day schools, an orphanage and Bible college.

It is exciting to see another generation of believers taking the leadership in ministries in India. Dr. Franks' children are involved in ministries he has started. Some of Dr. Kumar's children are working with him, but his oldest son Enoch has started a ministry about six hours from Bangalore, and his daughter Golda

and her husband have started a work about twelve hours from Bangalore.

Several of the men in the Bible college come from the northern part of India, very close to Burma (Myanmar). Friends of the graduates traveled five days to get to the graduation.

Two days of travel was on a bus, and three days by train.



Dr. Kumar has written two books that are the first two in a series that will cover

most of the major doctrines.

I hope that you will remember to pray for these ministries in India. As you know, we visit many mission fields around the world. I do not know of anyone doing so much with so little anywhere else on the globe.

Darleen and I are grateful for your kind and faithful support of our ministry with World Wide. It is always a joy to visit your churches and see those that labor together with us in this work.
