I cannot overstate the joy of attending services with more than two hundred men from all over Alaska. The singing and fellowship would make you want to build some tabernacles and stay awhile! Following the men's retreat, I preached in two churches in Anchorage and one in Wasilla before returning home.

We just finished a missions conference in Lewiston, Maine, and are now in DeWitt, Michigan. The Lord willing, we will go from here to Alpine, Tennessee, before going home for a few days.
