Thank you for praying for my sister. As you know, she had eighteen chemotherapy treatments, followed by major surgery. Two days following surgery, she tested positive for covid. The following day she fell, resulting in a broken hip which required a hip replacement the next day. The doctor has now discovered that in the fall, she also fractured her back. I am amazed at her positive attitude after this series of events in her life. She is having therapy, and when she is able, the chemo treatments will begin again. Please continue to pray for her.

We are busy in missions conferences again and will primarily be traveling in the Southeast until late November. Your continued prayers on our behalf are always appreciated. While we were in Flagstaff this summer, my right hip dislocated, and it is taking a little longer than I thought to heal. The doctor says that all is well, and that it does take two to three months to get back to normal. It has not hindered our travel or ministry, but I do find that it is necessary to stop and walk a bit more than usual.
