Dear Pastor,

Darleen and I are packed for the trip to Togo. However, everything is on hold for now. Both of my hips have been replaced. The first replacement was twenty-two years ago. That one wore out two years ago, so I had a revision done. It performed flawlessly for a year and a half until June of last year when I had my first dislocation. The second dislocation came in September, and the third happened in December. I am now scheduled for surgery on February 13, 2023. If the doctor only has to deal with the top part of the replacement, it will be five or six weeks of recovery. If he has to remove the shaft, recovery could take as much as six months. Please pray that the doctor will have the wisdom to determine exactly what is needed. He will not know until the surgery is underway.

Prayerfully the trip to Africa is simply postponed. I am looking forward to teaching the young men who are waiting until I can get there. It troubles me that my schedule is completely upside down, but nothing ever surprises our Lord. May His will be done.

Words fail to fully express our appreciation for your faithful prayers, financial support, and friendship. We are blessed to labor together with you in the service of the King.
