Greetings from Delta Junction,

Nancy and I praise the Lord for His goodness and the privilege we have to serve Him. "The LORD *is* good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him." Nahum 1:7. We have much to be thankful for. We have had many new opportunities to share God's Word with new Russians in the area and open doors into new Russian homes. We praise the Lord for the new support that has come in and for those that have increased their monthly support. We praise the Lord for all of you that so faithfully pray for us and pray that God will bless each of you.

We have had some set backs this winter. Peter has not been faithful in recent months and has been working in Wasilla much of the time. But we have had a faithful few that keep coming and we praise the Lord for them. We have had the opportunity to visit with some new Russians. Also, a few new Russians have come to our apartment requesting Bibles for their families. With each Bible we include the "God's Simple Plan of Salvation" tract in Russian. We were able to pass out 100 of the 2006 Joyful News Gospel Calendars in Russian throughout the community. Several Russians that attend other churches have requested Christian materials for their children and grandchildren. We praise the Lord that we have been able to help supply the materials they needed and pray that through this they will see Christ in us.

The Russian/English Bible that we have been able to get from the Russian Bible Society, has opened doors for us and given us opportunities to share God's Word with Russians that we have not had contact with before. One such family is the Yelenskaya Family. Like most of the Russians we have contact with, they are religious, but we are praying that we will continue to be able to visit with them and that they will see that salvation is through Jesus Christ alone. Please pray with us that God will open the eyes of those we have talked with in recent weeks. Pray with us also that the new contacts will remain open to our visits and that they will be saved. Russians that we have given tracts and New Testaments years ago but have not heard from in some time are visiting us and asking for our help. It seems God is opening the door for us once more to share His love with them. Sometimes we feel like outsiders and then a Russian will knock on our door asking for help. Please pray for us that we will always be faithful and that God will continue to use us for His honor and glory.

Please keep those in the fire department in your prayers also. One of the men has been going through some difficult times. He says he reads the New Testament I gave him. Although he made a profession of faith as a child, there is no fruit in his life to bear witness of that fact. Please pray that God will open his eyes and that he will realize that God is the only answer for his problems.

We appreciate everyone of you and pray that God will continue to bless you and use you for His honor and glory in all that you do. Please continue to pray for us here in Alaska.
