So we started meeting in our home. Regina, a dear Russian lady that was in that first meeting, took us in and became friends with us. She separated from the other Russians and began meeting with us and has been now for the past 10 years. We truly have much to praise God for.

One of the Malyk brothers, Fred, that was in that first meeting, has been a friend to us since we moved here. He and one of his sons came over to our house a few weeks ago asking for some Bibles. We praise the Lord that we still have an open door to be able to get the Gospel to these people. We think of all the Russians that we have had the opportunity to minister to and give tracts and Bibles to over the years. We pray that God will open their eyes so that they will see their need for true salvation. So many of them that we have met have been so religious but so lost.

The Timoshenko family continues to be faithful to the services. Sophia used to miss about every other service to go to the Pentecostal Church with some of her friends, but since the Timoshenko family has been coming she has not missed a service.

Peter has not been in a service in over two months. He has called when he has been in town. He only stays in Delta a few days and then returns to Wasilla.



Please continue to pray for him and his family.

We had a time of fellowship after a morning service two weeks ago and it was a real encouragement to us. Everyone seemed to have a good time. We were able to get to know Vitaliy and his wife as well as their children better.

We praise the Lord that we finally got the truck repaired and that the \$7,587.00 has been supplied. We thank the Lord for all of you that gave toward that need. We know God will bless you for it. We are trusting Him to supply the money that is needed for the other expenses that came up as a result of our truck being in the shop.

Nancy and I praise the Lord for all of you that so faithfully pray for us and give so that we can get the Gospel to the Russian speaking people in the Interior of Alaska.
