Greetings from the Interior of Alaska. Although winter is still a couple of months away, we have not had much of a summer. We are hoping for warmer weather next week. In the last two days it has rained over 3 inches and it is still raining. The temperature has been in the low 50's and upper 40's at night, and some of the higher mountains have received a dusting of snow. Thankfully it has melted, but it is a sign that winter is coming.

Nancy and I want to thank each of you for your prayers. We had to take an unexpected trip to North Carolina in June for a family emergency and were gone for 3 weeks. We thank the Lord for His goodness and His promise that He will never leave us nor forsake us. He is always there when we need Him. We ask that you continue to keep us and our families in your prayers.

When we returned to Alaska we heard that Peter is back in Wasilla, Alaska with his family. We do not know if he is here permanently or just visiting. We are praying that the Lord will supply the funds so that we will be able to travel to Wasilla to see him. Gas prices here in Delta are \$4.67 a gallon and even higher in some of the surrounding areas. It will cost us about \$300 in fuel to travel to Wasilla and back. But if it is the Lord's will for us to go see him, I know the Lord will supply the need. Although his family wants to move back here, Peter has said that he will never return to Delta Junction.

Since we have returned, Sophia has been faithful to attend the services. We also had a visitor for the Sunday night service. Please pray for Regina. She fell at her daughter's house. She twisted her left arm backwards and bruised it very badly. Her arm is now in a sling. But she refuses to let us take her to the doctor, preferring to use home remedies.

We thank the Lord for each of you, for your faithfulness in praying for us, and for your support of the ministry here in Delta Junction. Please continue to pray for us that God will use us greatly here, and that souls will be saved.
