and snow levels that have not been seen in the interior in along time, people come out for the services. Even a few men came out for our monthly prayer breakfast when it was -43.



We praise the Lord for His many blessings and for safety as we have been traveling a lot this winter visiting shut-ins here in Delta and traveling back and forth to the hospital in Fairbanks visiting a friend of ours that has been recently diagnosed with cancer in addition to the heart problems he has had for many years. There are so many that we know that are struggling with financial and physical needs, but their most serious needs are spiritual. "The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance." II Peter 3:9. We have witnessed to one man many times, but he still refuses to surrender to God. Please pray with us that he will be saved soon.
