Greetings from Delta Junction, Alaska. Because so much has taken place since I last wrote, I do not know where to start. Nancy continues to have good days and bad. The blood test in January showed that the percentage of cells with the chromosome mutation is down to 11% from 26% when she was diagnosed. We are still concerned about the kidney function. February showed improvement, but this week’s test was not as good. But God has been gracious through it all. We are thankful that she has more strength now and praise the Lord for all He has done and is doing.

Many of you have been praying for the financial need for the medicine. We are truly thankful for all the prayers. Partial assistance has come through and is good into April. Another source has approved us after that. We have also changed our insurance coverage as of March 15. We have been told that the new policy will cover the medicine after the deductible is met. If it does not, the other funding should help with the cost. We were surprised this week that the cost has risen to \$8300 per month. We did not realize that the assistance we have through April has a monthly limit of \$7500. As a result we had to pay \$806 instead of the \$100 we had been paying each month. But God is good and knows all about it. We do ask that you keep this need in prayer and pray for us to continue to use this circumstance for His honor and glory.
