Greetings from Delta Junction. I am so sorry for the delay in getting this letter out to you. Summer is here and as always, it is a busy time for everyone. But it is sad that at this time of year people seem to forget about God more than ever and concentrate more on the physical than the spiritual.

The Lord opened the door for me to begin going to the Interior Alaska Medical Clinic each morning at 8:30 to share a devotion and pray with the staff. This has offered opportunities to not only minister to the staff, but to some of the patients, as well as to individuals at the assisted living facility in the same building. Please keep this ministry opportunity in your prayers. When I was asked if I would be willing to take this on as a ministry, I told them that I would, but that I would not change or compromise on what I believe. Even though some have not liked what I have shared at times, the door remains open and God has given me the opportunity to share the Gospel with individuals as a result of the open door at the clinic.

We praise the Lord for all His blessings. The fire department of which I am Chaplain wanted to do something for us since Nancy was diagnosed with leukemia. We kept telling them that we know of others that need help more than we do. But they insisted. They recently held a spaghetti dinner fundraiser for us and invited the Delta community. We praise the Lord for His goodness and for all that gave to help us with the medical expenses which our insurance has not covered.

As some of you may know, I was in the hospital on May 24 for an emergency appendectomy and then again on June 2 for tests to determine why I was passing blood. We thank the Lord that it was nothing too serious and that medications and a change of diet should help.

We appreciate all the prayers and support from all of you. Please continue to keep Nancy in your prayers. It is a daily struggle for her, but praise the Lord, she is having more good days than bad.
