Even though we may not always see Him working, one thing we can know for sure is that He is always in control. He knows everything that we are facing and has a purpose in it. Even though we do not understand most of the time, all He desires from us is faithfulness and to trust Him no matter what comes our way. Nancy has a screen saver on her computer that says, "God is in control. I will trust Him." As my Pastor used to say "easy preaching, hard living". But it is the truth. God is in control and we must trust Him. Please continue to keep us in your prayers, that we will be found faithful and will trust Him no matter the circumstances.

We are rejoicing that God recently gave us the opportunity to lead an older man to the Lord. We met him as a result of volunteering as chaplain at the clinic where I go every morning for devotions and prayer. The man mentioned to the staff that he wanted to talk with me. I was able to meet with him at his residence. After an hour of sharing scripture and talking, he cried out to God to save him. We were meeting in his home twice a week for discipleship until his health declined and he had to move to a more advanced medical care facility in Fairbanks. I continue to visit with him, but not as often as I would like. Please keep this man in your prayers. There are several others who Nancy and I have met through the outreach of the clinic who are struggling, not only physically, but spiritually most of all. Please pray that God keeps this door open and that we will see others saved as well. We continue to hold services at the senior assisted living center every Sunday afternoon. There is also some interest from the staff that come out to listen. Many of them ask questions. Pray for this outreach as well, that God will speak to hearts and that this door will also stay open.

We praise the Lord for all of you that so faithfully pray for us. There is no way we could do all that we do or get through the many things that we face if it was not for our many faithful prayer partners. I cannot tell what it means to know that there are so many people praying for us. When I was in the hospital and the doctor did not know what was causing the problem and when we sit in the exam room in the cancer center, a peace comes from knowing that there are people praying. We are so blessed. Please know we appreciate all of you that not only pray for us, but so graciously support the work here in Delta with your financial giving. We realize things are tough everywhere and many of you are hurting financially as well but still continue to give. We want to thank you so much for your faithfulness.

Please continue to keep us in your prayers and keep the people of the interior of Alaska in prayer. Our truck is still holding together, praise the Lord. It has over 315,700 miles on it. By the grace God, it is still getting us down the highway. But please keep this need in prayer, that if it be God's will, He will provide us something a little newer with a lot less miles. Also remember our health needs. Nancy's numbers continue to improve. We praise God for the way He is touching her. As I am writing this letter, we are still waiting for results of the tests that were performed on me last week after my week in the hospital. The doctor still does not know what is causing my problem. I have a followup with the doctor on December 15th and Nancy has a cancer center appointment on the same day. Keep these appointments in your prayers, that God will be glorified no matter what we find out.
