

We are so thankful for all of you that are so faithfully praying for us and that are supporters of the work financially. So many of you have written to us, even some that we have never met in person, to tell us that you are praying for us. were able to go back to their own homes and one moved into senior housing here in town. Lord willing, we hope to be able to continue ministering to those still here locally as well as to the staff that are here in Delta. When we go to Fairbanks for errands or doctors' appointments, we try to visit some that were relocated there. We pray that the many that have heard the Gospel will see their need to be saved. It is our prayer that something that was said will pierce their heart and that they will cry out for mercy and be saved. So many are very hard and closed to anything to do with God but we know that God can save them. Please help us pray that we will live a life in front of the lost that will show them the love God has for them and what He did for them on the cross.

Thank you for praying for us during the wild fire that we had a few miles from our apartment. When the fire started we were experiencing 60 mph winds out of the south, the fire was not threatening us but so many that we know were right in its path. Only the grace of God could have

directed the fire in a way that no structures were lost and no one was injured. I saw the fire first hand and I know that it was all the prayers and our merciful God that spared the area. During my time at the fire I was able to pass out a few Gospel tracts and prayed with one young man about his family.
